Gathering for Good: Expanding our support of Colorado communities

The Wings Credit Union Foundation held its first ever Gathering for Good event Aug 18, in Colorado Springs and awarded \$250,000 to [Early Connections Learning Centers](#). Established more than a century ago, nonprofit Early Connections continues to provide high-quality early child education and care for children in Colorado Springs.

The funding will help expand access to affordable, high-quality childcare at a new Early Connections childcare facility planned for the Bradley Ridge affordable housing community in southeast Colorado Springs.

"Access to childcare affects nearly every part of a community's health and economic vitality," said Annie Snead, Wings Credit Union vice president of community impact and Wings Credit Union Foundation executive director. "When families can access affordable, high-quality childcare, children are set up for success and parents are better able to participate in the workforce."

The event at Wings headquarters in Colorado Springs brought together Wings leaders and dozens of local community impact leaders, including Colorado Springs **Mayor Yemi Mobolade**.

Quick banking tips as we become Wings

While our new name and brand is now in more places, how you bank with us is just the same. You may notice updates to our website URL and social media pages, but your accounts, services and experience remain the same. If something changes, we'll let you know ahead of time and guide you along the way.

- **Routing number** (307070005) — remains the same: it may be listed under Wings or Ent
- **Phone number** (800-525-9623) — remains the same
- **Ent checks** — use and reorder as needed
- **Ent debit cards** — use and we'll send a replacement card — look for Wings branded cards starting in September
- **Ent credit cards** — use and upon expiration we'll send a replacement card
- **Account numbers** — no immediate change: ongoing testing will determine if they stay the same
- **Colorado service centers** — existing locations remain open
- **Minnesota service centers** — full-service banking for Colorado members is slated for 2028/2029



Digital banking — use your usual login: the site is Wings branded

- **Bill pay** — choose Wings CU when setting up bill pay to your account
